Teachers & Group Leaders:

Expand your Heritage Walk tour experience with **Discover Heritage Walk**, a full-day field trip that combines a guided Heritage Walk tour with visits to two or more Star Attractions featured along the trail.

For students: **Discover Heritage Walk** incorporates multiple sites to illustrate over-arching themes that tie our history together; provides a dynamic experience with touchable objects and activities; stimulates students to discover the history in their own neighborhood.

For educators: **Discover Heritage Walk** accommodates large groups, includes discounted admission to the sites, and provides significant savings in transportation—all the sites are within walking distance of each other.

Discover Heritage Walk offers three engaging themes that align with the Maryland State Voluntary Curriculum for Social Studies. You may choose from:

- Historic Jonestown, A Community of Change (Grade 3)
- Citizens of Jonestown, Citizens of a New Nation (Grade 4)
- One Neighborhood, Many People (Grade 5)

Each program runs approx. 4 hours, but can be tailored to meet your needs. Chaperones are required in a ratio of 1 adult per 10 students. The role of chaperones is to encourage students to ask questions, make personal observations, and provide supervision.

To book your visit:

Discover Heritage Walk is offered year-round, 9:00am—4:00pm. Some restrictions apply for particular site visits. Reservations are required and need to be made at least three weeks in advance. Call 443.514.5900 or email phankins@heritagewalk.org to make your reservation. A packet of pre-visit materials, along with a confirmation letter and directions will be sent to you in advance of your visit.

Admission starts at \$12/person and includes **at least two site visits and a guided tour**. Discounts available for Baltimore City and Baltimore County Public School students. One complementary admission is offered to each chaperone for every ten students. A non-refundable 10% deposit is required to secure your reservation. Deposits can be applied to rescheduled tours for any changes made three or more weeks in advance. The balance is due three weeks before the reserved date.

Food service is not available at the museums, but space for enjoying a bag lunch or afternoon snack can be made with advance notice.
